In the Údolí Lapků z Drakova Valley there are the remains of the Drachenburg guard castle which was used as a customs house near the Quinburg castle. It was built as a customs station in the second half of the 13th century. The castle was situated on a rock that protrudes from the slope into the valley of the Černá Opava River so that it formed a natural obstacle to the trade route that passed here in the past. The name of the castle comes from the German word “drachen” – dragon. You can get to the castle along the Údolím lapků z Drakova Valley Nature Trail, located on the right side just before Lorenzo's smelter behind the Černá Opava River.
